in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release, unto the said R. B. McKinney, Eloise McKinney Ellis, Ruth McK. Smith, Edna Mae McK. Giles and Virgil McK. Coker

All my right, title and interest - present and future - in and to all those two said parcels or lots of land lying and being situate in Austin Township, containing 7 1/2 acres and 18 3/4 acres and being the identical lands in which I conveyed my interest to the grantees on April 18, 1936 by deed recorded in the office of the R. M. C. Greenville County, book 193, page 93 and reference is here made to that deed for a more definite and particular description of the property here conveyed.

It is to be understood and agreed that this conveyance covers and includes all of the said property whether it is now owned by the grantees or if by them having been conveyed to another or to others. Should any such conveyances have already been made then and in that case any additional rights or interest included in this deed and not covered and included in the original deed shall pass on to the present owners of such portions hereof as may have conveyed away.
