All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, known and designated as Lots #4, 5, 6, 7, and 8 of Block "C" of the Melville Land Company, a plat of which is recorded in the R. M. C. 's Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "A" at Page 97. Reference to said plat is made for a complete description. Lot #4 was conveyed to me by Melville Land Company on March 17, 1908, and the deed is recorded in the said office in Deeds, Volume "YYY" at page 281. Lots # 5, 6, 7, and 8 of Block "C" were conveyed to me by Olivia A. Aiken by deed dated August 22, 1921, and recorded in said Office in Deeds, Volume 78 at page 450.
