a corporation chartered under the laws of the State of South Carolina and having its principal place of business at Greenville in the State of South Carolina for and in consideration of the sum of Five Thousand and no/100ths (\$5,000.00) DOLLARS,

to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee(s) hereinafter named (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto Harold Edward Lavett, his heirs and assigns, forever:-

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon situate, lying and being on the Southeast side of Alaska Drive (formerly known as Morningside Drive) in the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being shown as Lot 3 on Plat of Parkview, made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, June 1942, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, in Plat Book "M", page 49, and having, according to said Plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:-

Beginning at an iron pin on the Southeast side of Alaska Drive at joint front corner of Lots 3 and 4, said pin also being 375 feet in a Northeasterly direction from the point where the Southeast side of Alaska Drive intersects with the Northeast side of Neely Drive and running thence with the line of Lot 4, S. 36-17 E. 150 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 53-43 E. 50 feet to an iron pin at corner of Lot 2; thence with the line of Lot 2, N. 36-17 W. 150 feet to an iron pin on the Southeast side of Alaska Drive; thence with the Southeast side of Alaska Drive S. 53-43 W. 50 feet to the beginning corner.

The Grantee agrees to pay the 1946 taxes.

This property is conveyed subject to the restrictive covenants which are recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, In Deed Book 245, page 138.
