I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County aforesaid, SEND GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, Edna L. Gilreath, Individually and as Administratrix of the Estate of Lois Morley, deceased.

on or about the 22nd. day of March in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and forty-six exhibited her complaint in the Court of Common Pleas, for the County aforesaid, against Leon F. Morley, et al.

demanding relief as to the real estate described in the complaint: and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the 3rd. day of May, 1946, and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a Decree

of the said Court, whereby it was adjudged and decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described, be conveyed by E. INMAN, Master in and for the County aforesaid, to Edna L. Gilreath

for the purposes mentioned in the said decree, as by reference thereto on file in said Court, will appear; (See Judgement Roll No. E-10571)

NOW, THEREFORE, Know All Men by These Presents, That I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County of Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid decree,

HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these Presents, DO GRANT, convey, and release unto the said Edna L. Gilreath

"All that certain lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, near Judson Mills, fronting on Piedmont Avenue 60 feet and running back in parallel lines 150 feet to the P. & N. right of way, and being known as Lot No. 17 as shown by plat recorded in Plat Book D, page 35, of a subdivision of lot known as Edgemont."

The consideration for the above conveyance, as fixed in the Decree of Court herein, is \$1090.25. The consideration was paid direct by the Grantee and was not paid to the Master.
