

6. The Husband and the Wife agree to separately support themselves by their own efforts. Neither shall have any claim or right to the services or earnings of the other, or to any other benefits, enjoyment or duties which would otherwise accrue by reason of the relationship of Man and Wife.

7. The Husband agrees that the Wife may assume her maiden name or may retain her married name and in the event the marital relationship is finally severed by divorce or the death of the Husband then the Wife and the children may cease to use the name of the Husband.

8. In the event either the Husband or the Wife shall sue for divorce or in the event a divorce degree is granted, the terms of this agreement shall remain in full force and effect, but nothing contained herein shall be construed as limiting or abridging the right of either party to maintain a suit for divorce.

9. This agreement shall be terminable in whole or in part only by agreement of both the Husband and the Wife signed by them in due form and recorded on the face of either of the duplicate original copies hereof.

10. It is understood and agreed that this agreement embraces a full and complete settlement of all property rights and marital rights of the parties hereto, and firmly and finally establishes the custody of the children in the wife.

To the faithful and just performance of the provisions of the within agreement the Husband and the Wife hereby bind themselves, their heirs, executors, administrators, personal representatives and assigns forever.
