in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release, unto the said J. S. Paget and his heirs and assigns:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Chick Springs Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, lying on the west side of the C. & D. Chevrolet building and north of the C. M. Ponder property, having the following courses and distances, to wit; Beginning on line formerly E. D. Green property, and runs thence N. 30 E. 197 feet to Wakefield corner; thence N. 75 W. 90 feet to a stone, W. F. Holtzclaw corner; thence 178 1/2 feet to old church corner; thence S. 61 1/2 E. 82 1/2 feet to the beginning corner. Also a right-of-way ten feet wide which was conveyed to Greer Furniture Company by J. H. Payne between property formerly owned by Baptist Church of Greer and what was formerly line of Mtr. Sally A. Green.
