in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release, unto the said C. L. Lindsay, and his heirs and assigns, all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

on the Southwest side of Orlando Avenue, near the City of Greenville, being known and designated as Lot No. 76 on plat of Paris Piney Park, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book H at Pages 19 and 20, and also being shown as Lot No. 76 on plat of Leawood Extension, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book M at Page 35, and having according to a recent survey made by R. E. Dalton, July 8, 1942, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Southwest side of Orlando Avenue, at joint front corner of Lots Nos. 75 and 76, said pin also being 551 feet in a Southeasterly direction from the point where the Southwest side of Orlando Avenue intersects with the Southeast side of Paris Mountain Road, and running thence with the line of Lot No. 75, S. 33-54 W. 150 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 56-06 E. 50 feet to an iron pin; thence with the line of Lot No. 77, N. 33-54 E. 150 feet to a stake on the Southwest side of Orlando Avenue; thence with the Southwest side of Orlando Avenue, N. 56-06 W. 50 feet to the beginning corner.
