in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of one dollar, and partition of real property of Estate of Wyatt Young McDaniel, M. D., deceased,

to us, Wyatt Y. McDaniel in hand paid, at and before the sealing of these presents by

in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release, unto the said Wyatt Y. McDaniel, his heirs and assigns forever:-

All our respective undivided, right, title, interest and estate, of, in and to all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Chick Springs Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, in the town of Taylors, on the north side of the National Highway, adjoining lands of W. R. Smith, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:-

Beginning at iron pin on the edge of the said Highway, Smith's corner, and runs thence N. 12 1/4 W. five hundred sixty-one (561) feet to iron pin at pasrure fence; thence S. 77-3/4 W. eighty-five and eight-tenths (85.8) feet to an iron pin; thence S. 12 1/4 E. five hundred seventy-six and two-tenths (576.2) feet to iron pin on the edge of said Highway; thence N. 86-3/4 E. eighty-nine and eight-tenths (89.8) feet to the beginning corner.
