NOW THEREFORE,

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, Roy Ayers,

in the State aforesaid

in consideration of the sum of One and no/100

DOLLARS

(\$1.00)

to me paid by Juanita Langston (Now Juanita Langston/ Sheets)

in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release, unto the said Juanita Langston

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Butler Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, about 5 miles east of Greenville Court House, Greenville, S. C., and lying about a half miles south of Roper Mountain Baptist Church, and having the following metes and bounds to wit:

BEGINNING at a pin in the road, corner of Roscoe Jones land and running thence with Jones Line S. 46-45 E. 909 feet to a pin at a branch on Roscoe Jones line; thence northeasterly with branch as a line, 665 feet to a pin near a gulley and said branch (Watson land, formerly known as McSwain land); thence with the McSwain-Watson land along the line of a discontinued old road N. 43-35 W., 915 feet to a pin in the first named road, and on line of Haynsworth land; thence along said road S. 42-30 W. 700 feet to the beginning corner, containing fourteen and eight tenths acres according to survey made by G. A. Ellis, August 26, 1938.
