to me paid by Daisy Revis

in the State aforesaid, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release, unto the said Daisy Revis, her heirs and assigns forever:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Saluda Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

Beginning on a large poplar on the East side of the Greenville Highway, said poplar being about 1000 feet South of the old Thompson Store Building, and running thence with said Greenville Highway, N. 40-45 W. 600 feet to a stake. Thence leaving the road and running thence N. 40-30 E. 230 feet to a point where a small branch runs into Fall Creek. Thence up and with the center of said branch as follows:

N. 51 E. 117 feet, N. 71-30 E. 75 feet, N. 39-40 E. 65 feet, N. 47 E. 91 feet., N. 41 E., 117 feet, N. 59 E., 94 feet., N. 21-30 E., 100 feet, N. 34 E., 159 feet, N. 48 E. 116 feet. Thence leaving the branch and running a hollow N. 55 E. 78 feet. Thence N. 65 E., 81 feet. Thence N. 57 E. 75 feet. Thence S. 60 E. 150 feet to a small poplar in the M. R. Bell line. Thence with his line two calls as follows S. 7 E. 475 ft. to a stake, thence S. 43 W. 1160 ft., to the point of BEGINNING and containing 17.3 acres be the same, more or less.
