on branch waters of Gap Creek north fork of Saluda river; Beginning on the rock corner of above the spring house; thence nearly East a straight line to a pine corner on the Timothy Pitman old tract; S. 70 W. 22 chs. to a White Oak; thence nearly west of a Chestnut oak near the grave yard; thence nearly S. West to a locust corner on John Gosnell land; thence to a Hickory binding on the Callahan land; thence with said line to a chestnut nearly west to a rock corner on the branch; thence up said branch to the Dennis Pitman old place; thence up the right hand prong of said branch to the Spring House; thence up the hollow to the beginning rock; corner and contining five (5) acres, more or less, with the execption of the grave yard; being a part of the Jacob Pruitt old place, and being the same tract of land conveyed to us by A. J. Pruitt, deed dated October 17, 1924.
