BEGINNING at a stake on the Eastern side of Bennett Street, Northern corner of Lot No. 118, and running thence with the line of said lot, S. 71-00 E. 143.8 feet to a stake, corner of Lot No. 134; thence with the line of said lot, N. 19-17 E. 5 feet to a stake; thence N. 71-00 W. 143.8 feet to a stake on Bennett Street; thence with the Eastern side of Bennett Street, S. 19-17 W. 5 feet to the beginning corner.
