All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Fairview Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, and more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at a stone corner of the H. M. Moore estate and J. C. Spillars lands, and runs thence along the line of the Spillars land S. 66 W. 1678 links to a stone; thence still along the line of the Spillars land S. 27 1/2 E. 380 links to a stone; thence still along the Spillars line S. 81 1/2 W. 3650 links to Reedy River; thence up said river N. 17 E. 495 links to a stone; thence still up said river 2 1/2 W. 580 links to mouth of the creek; thence up said creek S. 85 E. 450 links to a maple; thence still up said creek N. 85 E. 375 links to a willow; thence up said creek N. 25 E. 540 links to a stone; thence still up said creek N. 6 E. 1123 links to a stone; thence still up said creek N. 74 E. 1426 links; thence N. 49 1/2 E. 430 links to a stone; thence still up said creek N. 77 E. 754 links to a poplar tree; thence still up said creek N. 48 1/2 E. 575 links to a stone; thence leaving the creek and running S. 29 E. 1898 links to the beginning corner, containing 97 acres, more or less.
