Keller, and running thence with said Road S. 1-51 W. 70 feet to a stake where the Western line of the White Horse Road intersects the Western line of said Hunt's Bridge Road; thence with the White Horse Road S. 17-36 W. 332 feet to an iron pin; thence with property of James S. or Thelma E. Keller as follows: N. 83-0 W. 348.7 feet to iron pin; thence N. 1-30 E. 401.5 feet to a Poplar tree; thence with the line of property of J. K.
