A certain lot or parcel of land situated in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina on watters of South Pacolet river. Beginning at stone in the road running from Gosnells house to L. P. Barnett's at the ford of Greens Creek, thence S. W. to a pine corner, mine and Gosnell's corner, thence N W to a white oak, thence with line of me and Gosnell's to a Black Oak on branch, Parish corner, thence N. W. with the branch to a stone in old field well known corner, thence with the Parish line the old squirrel mountain road to a stone, thence N.E to a stone thence down the ridge to the branch and road to a maple corner, thence down the road towards Gosnells near N corner to a large apple tree on the big road, thence E. to the branch of Luthers spring, thence with the meanderings of the branch to Greens creek, stone corner, thence up the creek meandering with the creek to the beginning.
