A certain piece or tract of land situated in the County of Greenville, State of S. C. on waters of South Packolet river or a branch of said river. Beginning at stone in road running from Gosnell house to L. P. Barnett at the ford of Greens creek, thence S. W. to pine corner mine and Gosnell corner, thence N. W. to a White Oak, thence with line of me and Gosnell to a black oak on branch (Parish corner) thence N. W. with the branch to a stone in old field known corner, thence with Parish line to the old Squirrel Mt. road to a stone, thence N. E. to a stone in old road, thence down the ridge to the branch and road to a maple corner (now a stone) thence down the road toward Gosnells near branch to a large Apple tree corner on the big road, thence to the branch of Luther Barnett Spring, thence with the meanderings of the branch to Greens creek same corner, thence up the creek meanderings with the Creek to the beginning containing Sixty three acres, more or less.
