Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, and being the identical property conveyed to the Grantor herein by J. B. Hall and R. E. Cox by their deed dated June 15th, 1944, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville, County, South Carolina, in Deed Book No. 264 at page 399.
