All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in the State and County aforesaid, on the North side of Pendleton Street, in the City of Greenville and having the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at a point on Pendleton Street, which point is in the center of a brick wall separating this lot from a lot heretofore conveyed Anna Stathos and running thence with the center line of said wall, N. 20-30 W. 100 feet to an iron pin on the South side of an alley; thence with the South side of said alley, S. 69-30 W. 24 feet, more or less, to an iron pin; thence S. 20-35 E. 100 feet to a point on Pendleton Street; thence with the Northern side of Pendleton Street, N. 69-30 E. 23.8 feet, more or less, to the point of beginning.
