(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said  
James Herman Camper, his Heirs and Assigns, Forever:

All those certain pieces, parcels or lots of land situate, lying and being at the Southeast corner of the intersection of Lowndes Hill Road, (sometimes referred to as Airport Road or Wood Crossing Road) and Lindsay Avenue, near the City of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being shown as Lots 35 and 36 on Plat of East Lynne, made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, June 1931, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Plat Book "H", Page 195, and having, according to said Plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin at the Southeast corner of the intersection of Lowndes Hill Road and Lindsay Avenue and running thence along the East side of Lindsay Avenue, S. 9-14 E. 165.2 feet to an iron pin; thence with the rear line of Lots 73 and 74, N. 81-02 E. 50 feet to an iron pin; thence with the line of Lot 37, N. 9-14 W. 165.5 feet to an iron pin on the South side of Lowndes Hill Road; thence with the South side of Lowndes Hill Road, S. 80-43 W. 50 feet to the beginning corner.

This is the same property conveyed to us by deed of C. Kirby Hammond, dated March 7, 1946 and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Deed Book 298, Page 393.
