I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County aforesaid, SEND GREETINGS:

on or about the 15th day of May in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and forty-six exhibited his complaint in the Court of Common Pleas, for the County aforesaid, against Tallulah R. Green, et al.

NOW, THEREFORE, now All Men by These Presents, That I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County of Greenville, aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Eight Hundred Twenty-Five (\$825.00) Dollars, to me paid by the said W. P. Aiken

the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents, DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said W. P. Aiken

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, situate, lying and being in Greenville Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, about two miles west of the Greenville County Court House on Virginia Avenue, known and designated as Lot No. 19 of the subdivision known as Highland, as shown on plat thereof recorded in Plat Book C, page 146, of the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, and being the same lot of land conveyed to John Ray by J. A. Heatherly by deed recorded in Vol. 49, page 419."
