

receipt of said sum of money. After privately and separately examining the Defendant as to whether or not she made the agreement freely and voluntarily, the Court hereby orders and decrees that the Defendant be estopped hereafter from making any claim of dower against the Defendant in reference to the land above described or any land which the Plaintiff may hereafter acquire, and further, that the Defendant be forever barred from making any claim of dower in the premises above described. The Plaintiff and Defendant are to release each other from any and all marital claims, demands or obligations, such as support, maintenance, services, etc., and are to live separate and apart from each other the same as if no marriage contract had been entered into.
