Sir:

Reference is made to the lease on the post office quarters at Travellers Rest, S. C., which is at the rate of \$540 per year, including light, power, and water, and will expire on June 30, 1955.

We hereby agree to furnish additional space for the post office in the amount of 312 sq. ft. (13 x 24) by extending the building at the rear, for the remaining period of the existing lease for an additional rental of \$171.00, per year, including light, power, and water.

It is understood that the additional rental is to begin when the additional space is made available for the post office.

It is understood that all provisions of the existing lease are to remain in effect with respect to the additional space the same as to the space now being used.
