Office for Greenville County in Plat Book at Page , and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the Northern side of the Cedar Lane Road at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 4 and 5, and running thence with the line of Lot No. 5, N. 28-45 E. 325 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 84-40 E. 137 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 71-55 E. 41.5 feet to an iron pin, corner of Lot No. 3; thence with the line of Lot No. 3, S. 31 W. 395 feet to an iron pin on the Cedar Lane Road; thence with the Northern side of the Cedar Lane Road, N. 70-20 W. 147.5 feet to the beginning point.
