on the Northern side of the Cedar Lane Road, being shown as Lot No. 3 on plat of the property of the Estate of N. A. Howard made by J. Coke Smith on January 4, 1947, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book ✓ at Page ✓, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the Northern side of the Cedar Lane Road at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 3 and 4, and running thence with the line of Lot No. 4, N. 31-00 E. 395 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 71-55 E. 178.5 feet to an iron pin, corner of Lot No. 2; thence with the line of Lot No. 2, S. 28-15 W. 506 feet to an iron pin on the Northern side of the Cedar Lane Road; thence with the Northern side of the Cedar Lane Road, N. 67-03 W. 108.5 feet to an iron pin at bend; thence continuing with the Northern side of the Cedar Lane Road, N. 70-20 W. 39 feet to the beginning corner, corner of Lot No. 4, the point of beginning.

This lot is a portion of the tract of land devised by N. A. Howard to his wife Linda Burdine Howard for life, then to be divided among his children. Linda Burdine Howard died in January 1946, and the grantors and the grantee are all the children of N. A. Howard and Linda Burdine Howard.
