near the Town of Greer, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at a stake on the east side of Franklin Street Extension, at corner of property now or formerly belonging to J. O. Hightower Estate, and running thence along said Franklin Street Extension in a northerly direction sixty and one-quarter (60-1/4) feet, more or less, to a stake on the eastern side of said Franklin Street Extension at corner of property now owned by R. B. Vaughn; thence in an easterly direction along said R. B. Vaughn property to a stake at corner of W. M. Miller property; thence in a southerly direction along the said W. M. Miller property sixty and one-quarter (60-1/4) feet, more or less, to a stake at corner of W. M. Miller property and property now or formerly belonging to J. O. Hightower Estate; thence in a westerly direction along the boundary line of J. O. Hightower Estate property to the beginning corner.
