beginning on North side of Alley (known as Griffin Street) at corner of Lot #2; thence with line of lot #2 N. 18 E. 75 feet to corner of Brissey's lot; thence with line of Brissey's lot N. 72- W. 40 feet to corner in line of Brissey's lot; thence S. 18 W. 75 feet to Griffin Street; thence with Griffin Street S. 72- E. 40 feet to the beginning corner, being a part of Lot #3 according to plat recorded in plat Book "A" page 231 in the R.
