All of our undivided right, title and interest, of, in and to: All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Glassy Mountain Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning on a stake, C. S. West and B. C. Adkins line in old road and runs thence S. 82 3/4 E. 1.84 to a stake; thence N. 30 1/2 E. 26.38 to a stone on line of D. R. Evins estate; thence N. 24 3/4 W. 22.37 to a stake on Greens Creek; thence up creek about Seven (7) chains to the mouth of a small branch; thence up small branch about Eleven (11) chains to a stone; thence S. 83 1/2 W. 85 links to a stone on road; thence with road, S. 1.5 E. 6.08 to turn in said road; thence S. 18 1/2 E. 6.30 to turn in said road; thence S. 10 1/2 E. 3.72 to turn in said road; thence S. 51 1/2 E. 2.77 to turn in said road; thence S. 10 1/2 E. 3.70 to turn in said road; thence S. 12 W. 1.30 to turn in said road; thence S. 27 1/2 E. 1 chain to turn in said road; thence S. 1 1/4 W. 2.24 to a stone on west side of road; thence up old road S. 7.40 W. 4 chs. to the beginning corner, containing Forty Nine and 3/10 (49.3) acres, more or less, bounded by lands of B.
