and being situated on both sides of All Creek, adjoining lands now or formerly owned by Anderson Staton, John Gordan, John Ward, Anderson Gordan, and others and being described as follows:

BEGINNING at a rock on the West Bank of Fall Creek at place of Lynn, and runs E. 30 poles to a rock; thence S. 36 1/2 poles to a rock on Mrs. Gosnell line; thence in an easterly direction with the Gosnell line to a rock on Gosnell corner; thence N. 16 E. 11 poles to a rock Statons corner; thence N. 22 W 1 1/4 poles to a stake at the old black oak corner; thence with Statons line N. 65 E. 55 poles to an ash on the Constant branch; thence down said branch 7 1/4 poles to a large chestnut; thence N. 57 W. 11 1/2 poles to fork of creek; thence up creek N. 20 E. 2 poles to ford of same; thence with the road leading to John Wards 38 poles to a small white oak on the bank of creek; thence up creek 10 poles; thence N. 48 W. 16 1/2 poles to a small maple, near a road; thence S. 17 W. 13 1/2 poles to a rock on edge of a road at place of small white oak, William Wards corner; thence S. 80 W. 10 poles to a large black oak John and William Wards corner; thence S. 80 W. 10 poles to a large black oak John and William Wards corner; thence S. 15 E. 73 poles with John Wards line to a small dogwood at place of old Spanish oak said Wards corner; thence with his line S. 68 1/4 W. 55 poles to a white oak his corner; thence with his S. 18 W. 66 poles to stake at place of old Chestnut corner; thence S. 68 E. 5 1/4 poles to Chestnut; thence S. 28 W. 20 poles to a poplar stump. Said Wards corner; thence E. 70 poles with John Wards and Anderson Gordans lines to the beginning, containing 140 acres, more or less.
