KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That We, Lora M. Davis, Joseph E. Davis and Sarah Davis Bishop,

in the State aforesaid.
in consideration of the sum of Four Hundred Fifteen (\$415.00) DOLLARS

to us in hand paid, at and before the sealing of these presents by Mauritz Veneida Odam

in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release, unto the said Mauritz Veneida Odam and her heirs and assigns forever;

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Highland Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, lying on the South side of a paved road that leads from the Lenoah School by Camp Creek to Tigerville, near the said Lenoah Public School, being all of tract No. 14 on a plat of the W. W. Davis Estate property made by H. L. Dunahoo, Surveyor, dated January 23, 1947, and having the following courses and distances:

BEGINNING on an iron pin, corner with Mrs. Cora H. Odam's land, and being the southwestern corner of the tract herein conveyed, and runs thence with Mrs. Odam's line N. 36.15 E. 300 feet to a stake on the South edge of said road; thence with the southern edge of said road in a southeasterly direction 354 feet to a stake, corner of lot No. 15; thence with line of lot No. 15 S. 42.10 W. 480 feet to a stake; thence N. 25.30 W. 243 feet to a stake; thence N. 34.30 W. 100 feet to the beginning corner, containing Three and one-tenth (3.1) Acres, more or less.
