KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I Frances Sloan for and in consideration of the premises herein stated, have agreed to and do hereby commit the care, maintenance, custody, education, and support of my child, Betty Jean Sloan of the age of 1 yr. 6 mos. having been born Sept. 8, 1945 ~~days~~ of for and during his minority.

Together with the rights, privileges, and benefits that could be exercised by me, as parent, over and in respect to said child.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, the said child against me and any and all persons claiming or to claim any interest, right, or privilege through me in and to the said child.

I also agree that I will not attempt to locate the said child and will not by any legal proceedings institute any action for the recovery of said child at any time in the future.
