KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That We, Lora M. Davis, Joseph E. Davis and Sarah Davis Bishop,

in the State aforesaid

in consideration of the sum of Ninety (\$90.00) DOLLARS

to us in hand paid, at and before the sealing of these presents by Burnett Cannon

in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release, unto the said Burnett Cannon and his heirs and assigns forever:

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Highland Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, lying on the West side of a paved road that leads from Oneal by Lenoah Public School to Highland and Tigerville, lying just North from said school, being all of lot No. 3 on a plat of property made for the W. W. Davis Estate by H. L. Dunahoo, Surveyor, dated January 23, 1947, having the following courses and distances: BEGINNING on a stake on the West side of said road, joint corner of lots 2 and 3, and runs thence with line of lot No. 2 N. 88.30 W. 300 feet to a stake on line of lot No. 11; thence S. 1.30 W. 200 feet to a stake, corner of lot No. 4; thence with line of lot No. 4 S. 88.30 E. 300 feet to a stake on the West side of said road; thence with the West edge of said road N. 1.30 E. 200 feet to the beginning corner.
