(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Truman H. Henderson, his Heirs and Assigns forever

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Chick Springs Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

about one half mile North from Greer, lying West of the present Mosteller Road, and being a part of the original lot set off for the WILSON GRAVEYARD, being bounded on the North and East by lands of Truman H. Henderson (formerly Mrs. Ellen W. Crain), on the South and West by other portion of the WILSON GRAVEYARD, and having the following courses and distances, to wit:

Beginning on an iron pin on the original line of the GRAVEYARD property at a point 88 feet from an iron pin and concrete monument in the old abandoned Mosteller Road, and runs thence with the said original line N. 81-10 E. 72 feet to an iron pin and concrete monument, old corner; thence S. 24-30 E. 93.2 feet to a point on another original line of the GRAVEYARD property; thence a new line S. 87-51 W. 27.8 feet to an iron pin, new corner; thence another new line N. 48-39 W. 110.7 feet to the beginning corner, and containing 4300 square feet.
