NOW, THEREFORE,

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That We, Lora M. Davis, Joseph E. Davis and Sarah Davis Bishop,

in the State aforesaid  
in consideration of the sum of Seven Hundred Eighty (\$780.00) DOLLARS

to me in hand paid, at and before the sealing of these presents by Cleve Lynn

in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release, unto the said Cleve Lynn and his heirs and assigns forever;

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Highland Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, lying on the West side of the paved leading from Oneal by Lenoah School to Highland and Tigerville, near said Lenoah Public School and North therefrom, being all of lots Nos. 5, 6, 7, and 8 on a plat of property made for the W. W. Davis Estate by H. L. Dunahoo, Surveyor, dated January 23, 1947, having the following courses and distances:

Beginning on an iron pin, joint corner of lot No. 8 and the Lenoah School on the West edge of said road, and runs thence with the school line S. 62 W. 333 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 1.30 E. 968 feet to a stake, corner of lot No. 4; thence with line of Lot No. 4 S. 88.30 E. 300 feet to a stake on the West edge of said road; thence with the West edge of said road S. 1.30 W. 800 feet to the beginning corner.
