Chambers, Charlie F. Woodall, J. D. Woodall, D. A. Woodall, Dazzie W. Porter, R. B. Woodall, Rufus C. Woodall, Logan Woodall, Clelie W. Bridwell and W. T. Woodall, their heirs and assigns:

All my right, title, interest or claim in and to the following described property:

All that lot, peice, or parcel or land situate in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, on a plat of property made by R. E. Dalton, September, 1924, said plat hereto referred to revised and restaked by W. J. Riddle, Surveyor, 1940, and being known and designated as Lot No. 1 in Section C, containing .36 of an acre of land and more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at an iron pin on the corner of Emil Avenue and Agness Street and running in a northeasterly direction along Agness Street 160 feet to corner of lot No. 2; thence in a northerly direction along western line of lot No. 2 108.6 feet to an iron pin on said western line of lot No. 2; thence in a southwesterly direction along southern line of lot No. 6 177.2 feet to iron pin at edge of Emil Avenue, the joint corner of lots Nos. 1 and 6; thence along Emil Avenue 75 feet to beginning corner, and containing .36 acres.
