

TITLE TO REAL ESTATE

STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA

GREENVILLE COUNTY.

WHEREAS, a street or avenue known as Saluda Street was shown on a plat of Cherokee Park, a plat showing the map, with said street as sixty feet in width, being recorded in Plat Book "A", page 130, R. M. C. Office for said County;

WHEREAS, said street appears as sixty feet wide on said map, running from Grove Road to Conestee Avenue; and

WHEREAS the County of Greenville has heretofore accepted said street to the extent of only fifty feet in width, and has never claimed said street, except as to fifty feet width, and has never used or accepted the additional width, and finds it impracticable to maintain sixty feet width and does not intend to use more than fifty feet width for said street and has abandoned the excess width, but does hereby adopt said street as shown by Plat recorded in Plat Book "K", page 155, in said R. M. C. Office.

NOW THEREFORE this instrument and resolution by the Supervisor of Greenville County does hereby refuse to accept and does hereby formally abandon so much of said Saluda Avenue or Street in excess of fifty feet in width, running from Grove road to Conestee Avenue so that the ten foot strip designated as strip A and B on the South side of Saluda Street or Avenue according to plat in plat Book "K", page 155 and beginning at Grove Road and extending to Conestee Avenue (the same never having been used by this County nor claimed by it) is hereby released from any claim the County may have had; and that the intention of this County is to refuse the said strip of land as a part of said Street or Avenue.
