All that certain strip, piece or parcel of land situate at or near GREENVILLE, in the County of Greenville and State of South Carolina, lying and being on the northwesterly side of original single track railraod at Atlanta and Charlotte Air Line Railway (now used for spur or industrial track by Southern Railway Company), more particularly described as follows:
