M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "G", Page 20, and being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at an iron pin at the intersection of Belmont Avenue and Crescent Avenue and running thence along Crescent Avenue N. 82-00 W. 165 feet to iron pin; thence N. 4-15 E. 112.5 feet to iron pin; ~~thence N. 4-15 E. 112.5 feet to iron pin;~~ thence S. 84-35 E. 164.75 feet to iron pin in Belmont Avenue; thence along Belmont Avenue S. 4-15 W. 120 feet to beginning corner.
