KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, John O. Langston

in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of one dollar and contract for
services rendered, Dollars:
to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents
by L. E. Wooten
(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents
do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said L. E. Wooten

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville
County, State of South Carolina all those two lotsof land on the southern side
of Verner Springs Road, near the City of Greenville, being known as
lots Nos. 365 and 366 on plat of west Park, made by A. D. Neves in
May, 1913, recorded in Plat Book "C", at pages 79 and 80 and the
adjoining one-half of the old right of way of Duke Power Company,
as shown on said plat, and described as follows:

BEGINNING at a stake at the southwestern corner of Verner Springs
Road and Cherry Street, and running thence with the southern side
of Verner Springs Road in a westerly direction 89.2 feet to a stake
at corner of lot No. 364; thence with the line of said lot in a
southerly direction, 264 feet, more or less, to a point in the
center of said abandoned right of way; thence with the center of
said abandoned right of way in a northeasterly direction 219 feet,
more or less, to a point on the western side of Cherry Street;
thence with the western side of Cherry Street in a northerly
direction 40 feet, more or less, to the beginning corner.
