C., and known as the Rocky Creek Church Cemetery of the said Church, being designated and marked by cement markers and known as lot No. 4 in Section 4 and containg 200 square feet.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD said lot to said Mrs H M Smith and his heirs and assigns forever, to be used for the interment of dead white persons only, and to be held, used, conveyed, devised or descend subject to the By-Laws, Rules and Regulations for the Cemetery of said church, at present of force or as hereafter amended or adopted and as may be shown by the minutes or other records of said Church.

Witness the seal of Rocky Creek Baptist Church and the hand of W M Gresham its Chairman of Board of Deacons, and countersigned by Robert Montgomery the Secretary of the Church as provided by its minutes this 21 day of July A.D. 1947.
