CERTIFICATE OF INCORPORATION

WHEREAS, W. E. Curry and H. Campbell
both of Greenville S. C.

two or more of the officers or agents appointed to supervise or manage the affairs of IODINE STATE BEAGLE CLUB

which has been duly and regularly organized, did on the 5TH day of November, A. D. 1947, file with the Secretary of State a written declaration setting forth:

That at a meeting of the aforesaid organization held pursuant to the by-laws or regulations of the said organization, they were authorized and directed to apply for incorporation.

That the said organization holds, or desires to hold, property in common for a Religious, Educational, Social, Fraternal, Charitable or other eleemosynary purpose, or any two or more of said purposes, and is not organized for the purpose of profit or gain to the members, otherwise than is above stated, or for the insurance of life, health, accident or property; and that three days' notice in the Greenville Piedmont, a newspaper published in the County of Greenville has been given that the aforesaid Declaration would be filed.

AND WHEREAS, That said Declarants and Petitioners further declared and affirmed:

FIRST. Their names and residences are as above given.

SECOND. The name of the proposed Corporation is IODINE STATE BEAGLE CLUB

THIRD. The place at which it proposes to have its headquarters or be located is Neely Ferry Road
Greenville County, S.C.

FOURTH. The purpose of the said proposed Corporation is to create, encourage and promote interest in owning, breeding, training and showing of Beagles and other dogs and generally to create and encourage interest in out-door sports and pastimes.

SIXTH. That they desire to be incorporated. in perpetuity.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, W. P. Blackwell, Secretary of State, by virtue of the authority in me vested, by Chapter 158, Article III, Code of 1942 and Acts amendatory thereto, do hereby declare the said organization to be a body politic and corporate with all the rights, powers, privileges and immunities, and subject to all the limitations and liabilities, conferred by said Chapter 158, Article III, Code of 1942 and Acts amendatory thereto.

Sections 8158-8159 and 8168 GIVEN under my hand and the seal of the State, at Columbia, this 5th

day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and forty-seven and in the one hundred and seventy-second year of the Independence of the United States of America.
