KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That W.K. Golightly

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by
these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

Pearl Howard, her heirs and assigns forever:

All that parcel or tract of land containing Forty (40) Acres, more or less, in Highland Township of Greenville County, State aforesaid, lying and being on the South side of the Jordan Road, bounded by lands of Ben Tate, J.O. Plumblee, John Carmen and myself, having the following courses, to wit:

Beginning at the intersection of the Jordan Road and small road leading across field, corner of Ben Tate land, and running thence along Ben Tate's line in a southerly direction to Wild Cat Creek, J.O. Plumblee's corner; thence along J.O. Plumblee's line down said creek to intersection with branch; thence up and with said branch to spring (white oak corner); thence along dividing line to the center of Jordan Road; thence with and along said Jordan Road in an eastern direction to the beginning corner.

This deed intends to and does hereby convey all that land situate and lying on the South side of the said Jordan Road as described in a deed to me by Mallie Robertson Lyda, dated August 2, 1933, recorded in the R.M.C. Office in Greenville in Deed Book 171, page 139; less, however, the tract of land heretofore conveyed by me to J.O. Plumblee, and reserving to myself all of the said tract of land that lies on the North side of the said Jordan Road.
