All that piece, parcel or lot of land in **Greenville** Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, known and designated as Lot No. 111 as shown on Map #2 of Camilla Park Subdivision, property of John B. Marshall Estate, made by W. J. Riddle, Surveyor, December 1943, and recorded in the Greenville County R. M. C. Office in Plat Book M, page 85, and according to said plat more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the west side of Mary Street, corner of Lot No. 110, which iron pin measures 197 feet south from the southwestern intersection of Frances Avenue and Mary Street, and running thence along line of Lot No. 110, S. 85-21 W. 233 feet to iron pin at rear corner of Lots Nos. 110 and 111; thence along rear line of Lot No. 94, S. 6-42 E. 80.1 feet to iron pin at rear joint corner of Lots Nos. 111 and 112; thence along line of Lot No. 112, N. 85-21 E. 230.1 feet to iron pin on Mary Street; thence along Mary Street N. 4-39 E. 80 feet to the point of beginning.
