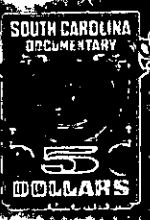
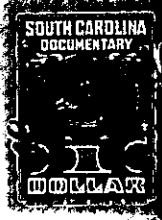

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we, JOHN OSTEEN AND GERTIE LEE OSTEEN,

in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of... Twenty-six hundred and 00/100 (\$2600.00)

***** Dollars to us in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by ALICE M. TILLOTSON,

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said.....

Alice M. Tillotson, her heirs and assigns forever,

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, known and designated as Lot No. two (2), in Block "M", in a sub-division known as park place, plat of which is recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book "A", at page 119, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a point on the west side of Second Avenue, corner of Lots Nos. 1 and 2, and running thence along the dividing line between said lots in a westerly direction one hundred and fifty (150) feet to an alley; thence along the east side of said alley in a northerly direction fifty (50) feet to a point, joint rear corner of lots nos. 2 and 3; thence along the dividing line between said lots Nos. 2 and 3 in an easterly direction one hundred and fifty (150) feet to a point on the west side of Second Avenue; thence along the west side of Second Avenue in a southerly direction fifty (50) feet to the point of beginning. This lots fronts fifty (50) feet on Second Avenue and runs back in parallel lines one hundred and fifty (150) feet, and has thereon a 3-room house and a one-room house.

The above described land is identically the same conveyed to us by W. I. Johnson on the 27th day of October, 19 45, deed recorded in office Register of Mesne Conveyance for Greenville County, in Book 283 Page 242
