KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, \*\* Ellen W. Crain,

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents  
do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Nancy W. Finley, her heirs and assigns  
forever:-

All my undivided one-half right, title, interest and estate, of, in  
and to

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Highland Township, Greenville  
County, State of South Carolina, in Highland School District, containing four  
hundred acres, more or less, and having the following courses and  
distances, metes and bounds, to-wit:-

Beginning at iron pin in the Highland surfaced Road, on the Robinson  
corner, and runs thence S 34½ E 9.27 chains to a stake on a branch;  
thence with the branch as the line, S 83 E 8.45 chs to a bend in the  
branch; thence S 64 E 5.23 chains to a bene in branch; thence S 56½ E  
8.06 chains to bene; thence S 80 E 3.33 to the R. L. Lindsey branch;  
thence with the meanderings of the R. L. Lindsey branch 29.64 chains  
to a sweetgum; thence S 6¼ E 22.10 chains to a chestnut; thence S 85¼  
E 12.89 chains to a stone; thence S 25 W 17.80 chains to a stone  
near a pine on the bank of the old Jordan Road; thence S 86 W 2.60  
chains to a bend in said road; thence S 80½ W 7.55 chains to a bend  
in said road; thence N 37 W 3.14 chains to a point in said road;  
thence N 24 E 6.95 chains to a stone-pile on top of Little Mountain;  
thence N 52 W 52.50 chains to a stone near the Greenville Road; thence  
N 8½ E 5.50 chains to a stone on the Harrison line; thence S 73 W  
37.75 chains to a stone, on Barton corner; thence N 5 W 21.65 chains  
to a stone; thence S 81½ W 3.92 chs; thence N 8¼ E 39.25 chs to a  
stone in the pasture near the road; thence N 19 E 20.00 chs to a  
stone on the Ballenger corner; thence S 41¼ E 43.75 with the Leonard
