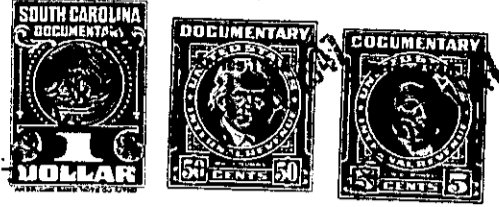

do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said R. K. Taylor, Jr.

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Chick Springs Township,

County, State of South Carolina, near Paris Station being known and designated as Lot 141 according to the plat of Super Highway Home Sites made by Dalton & Neves, May 1946, as recorded in plat book "P", at Page 53, subject to building and other restrictions as set forth in an instrument recorded in Deed Book 291, pages 369 and 370. Said records are in the Office of Register of Mesne Conveyance for Greenville County. Said lot has the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on Broad Vista Boulevard and being a joint corner; and running thence along joint side line of Lots 141 and 137 S. 74-56 W. 105 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 70-37 W. 134.4 feet to the center of a five foot strip in the rear reserved for utilities and being joint rear corner of Lots 141 and 142; thence along joint side line of Lots 141 and 142 N. 83-15 E. 205.5 feet to an iron pin on Broad Vista Boulevard and being joint front corner of Lots 141 and 142; thence along Broad Vista Boulevard S. 15-30 E. 85 feet to the beginning corner.
