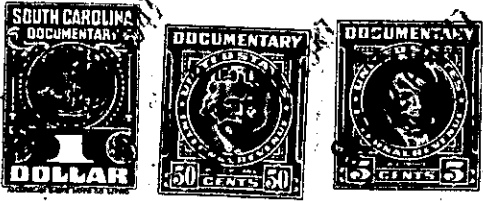

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, Pauline W. Foster

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents
do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said W. A. Ashmore, his heirs and
assigns

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Paris Mountain Township, Greenville
County, State of South Carolina and having the following metes and bounds, to-
wit:

BEGINNING at a point in the Dreamland-Paris Mountain Road,
the joint front corner of this tract and a tract (No. 5) belonging
to Russell, and running thence with said road N. 3-45 E. 105 feet;
thence still with said road N. 13-15 W. 177 feet; thence still with
said road N. 9-15 E. 104 feet; thence still with said road N. 9-45
W. 98 feet to point in line of tract No. 4, property of Robert T.
Ashmore; thence with his line S. 50 W. 102 feet to joint corners of
tracts 3, 4 and 5; thence with line of tract No. 3, S. 22 W. 439 feet;
thence S. 66 E. 225 feet to a point in said Dreamland Paris Mountain
