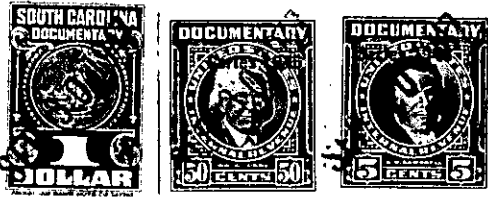

Court House, S. C. being known and designated as Lot number twelve
(12) according to the plat recorded in Plat Book "Q", page 135, in R.
M. C. Office for said Greenville County having a frontage on the East
side of the Street (now unknown named) of 51.5 feet a depth of 126.5
feet on North line 100 feet on rear line; and 135.7 feet on South line.
