All that piece, parcel or lot of land in **Butler** Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, known as a portion of the Irby Vaughn land, located about eight miles from the City of Greenville, on the branch waters of Brushy Creek, and being a portion of the land conveyed to Gentry Vaughn by Irby R. Vaughn by deed dated November 11, 1939, recorded in the office of the R. M. C. for Greenville County in Vol. 215, page 278. Said tract of land here conveyed contains one acre, more or less, and is known as Tract No. 1 on a plat made by J. Mac Richardson, Registered Land Surveyor, in July, 1947. It is all of the land owned by the grantors from the tract above referred to, on the northwest side of a surface treated road and begins in the said road at a sharp bend thereof at an iron pin and runs thence along the road north 25-41 E. 392.2 ft. to an iron pin in said road at the extreme western tip of Tract No. 2 on the Richardson survey; thence continuing along said road N. 25-41 E. 201 ft. to the corner at iron pin; thence leaving road and running S. 39-30 W. 615.1 ft. to an iron pin; thence S. 64-01 E. 146.9 ft. to the beginning corner.
