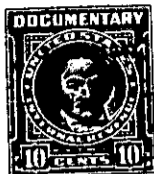

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents  
do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said ...Harrison T. Stone and Pearl L. Stone,  
their heirs and assigns, forever:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 46, as shown on revised plat of Shannon Terrace made by H. S. Brockman, Surveyor, in January 1930, and revised by R. E. Dalton in June 1935, recorded in R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book L at page 91, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a stake on the East side of Brookview Circle at the Northwest corner of Lot No. 45 and running along line of said lot, N. 82-08 E. 202 feet to a stake on the West side of Hilltop Drive; thence along West side of Hilltop Drive, N. 7-52 W. 50 feet to a stake at corner of Lot No. 47; thence along line of Lot No. 47, S. 82-08 W. 205.5 feet to a stake on the East side of Brookview Circle; thence along the East side of Brookview Circle, S. 11 E. 50 feet to the beginning corner.

This is the same property conveyed to us by deed of Carrie S. Matheny dated March 4, 1946 and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 288, page 196.

Said lot is shown on Township Block Book as No. 221-2-5.

The Grantees are to pay 1947 taxes.
