All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Paris Mountain Township, Greenville County, State  
of South Carolina, being described as follows according to plat by Dalton,  
November, 1934;

Beginning at a stone corner on the east side of New Poor House Road and  
a corner of the Bruce Lipscombe tract and running thence with Lipscombe  
tract, S. 76-19 E. 350 feet to a stake, corner on East Poor House Branch;  
thence down the branch a traverse line as follows: S. 2-37 W. 206 feet  
to bend; thence S. 8-45 W. 275 feet to bend; thence S. 2-30 W. 100 feet  
to stake on branch; thence leaving branch N. 80 W. 420 feet, more or less,  
to a stake on New Poor House Road; thence with said road as line  
N. 23-20 E. 215 feet to angle; thence N. 7-41 E. 425 feet to the be-
